On March 8th Phoenix voters will be asked to renew the APS franchise agreement with the City of Phoenix by voting yes on Proposition Number 2.

The franchise, placed on the ballot by the City Council, gives APS the right to continue using public rights-of-way to safely and efficiently construct our electrical facilities and plan for the future in your community. In exchange, we pay a franchise fee of 2 percent to the City of Phoenix.

This year, the APS franchise payment to the City is nearly \$15 million. That contribution to the City's income helps provide the services that make Phoenix a great place to live — everything from parks and recreation to libraries and police.

We hope that you will vote YES on the APS franchise agreement to continue a 75-year partnership and a commitment to Phoenix's future.
