

APS CENTRAL PHOENIX LINE UPGRADE PROJECT

APS is working to upgrade a critical underground transmission line in central Phoenix - the “backbone” of the metro Phoenix 230kV transmission system. This project supports reliability for customers by replacing a line that is reaching the end of its design life and supports growing energy needs by expanding the capacity of the line.

To remove and replace the underground line, scheduled for late 2026, APS’s contractor, Ferreira UTEC, will access manholes at various locations along the project route. In some instances, this will require large equipment near the manhole site to remove existing cable, run a robotic device through the pipeline to evaluate its integrity, and install new cable.

To prepare for this effort, initial work will take place at the APS Substation on Campbell Avenue as early as mid-September 2025.

Campbell Avenue, between 10th Street and 12th Street

Scheduled to begin in mid-September: Construction will take place onsite at the APS Substation on Campbell Avenue at 11th Street. In addition, work will take place in Campbell Avenue to identify existing underground utilities to minimize conflicts during construction.

Scheduled to begin in early October: Construction will take place in Campbell Avenue, just west of 11th Street, to trench and install pipe to realign the 230kV pipeline.

- To accommodate the planned work, Campbell Avenue may be closed to travel near 11th Street. Residents near the planned work will receive additional information prior to construction.
- About one week prior to any road closure, message boards will be placed in the neighborhood and include closure dates.
- Work in Campbell Avenue is expected to take 3-4 weeks to complete.
