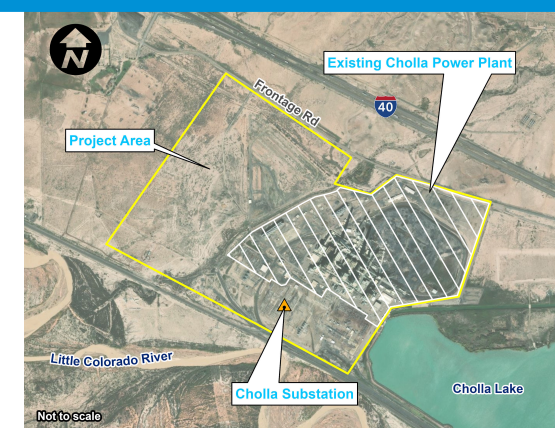

Cholla Power Plant (existing units)

Arizona Public Service Company (APS) is planning to convert two units from coal to natural gas at its Cholla Power Plant in your community. If approved, this conversion could add approximately 380 megawatts of additional energy, enough power to serve about 61,000 Arizona homes.

The Cholla Power Plant has been an integral part of the Joseph City community since 1962. The facility historically operated as a coal-fired power plant and played a long-standing role in supporting reliable energy for Arizona. The plant's remaining coal units were retired in 2025 as a result of federal environmental mandates. This project supports reliable, affordable energy for our customers, making the most of existing infrastructure and helping meet growing energy needs with a cost-effective, around-the-clock resource.

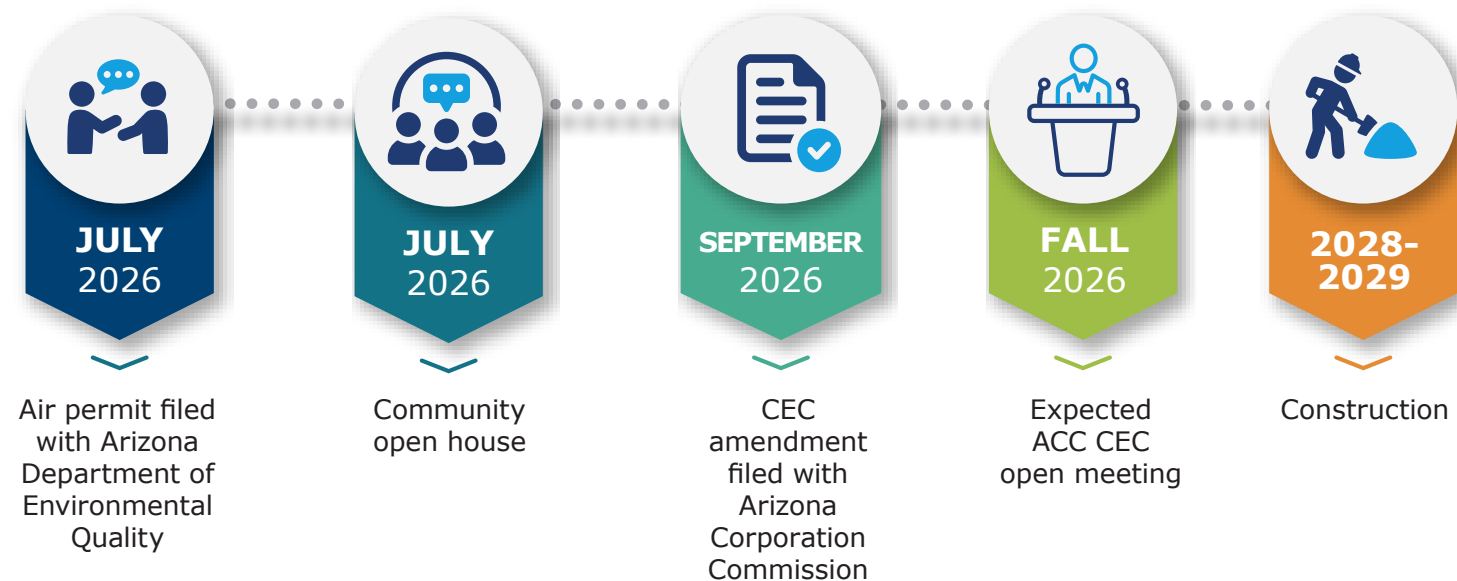


WHY?

As demand for energy in Arizona grows, natural gas is critical to deliver reliable service for all customers. Repurposing the site would allow APS to add new generation more efficiently and cost-effectively than developing a new location, while continuing to support system reliability and maintaining flexibility as Arizona's energy needs evolve.

What's next?

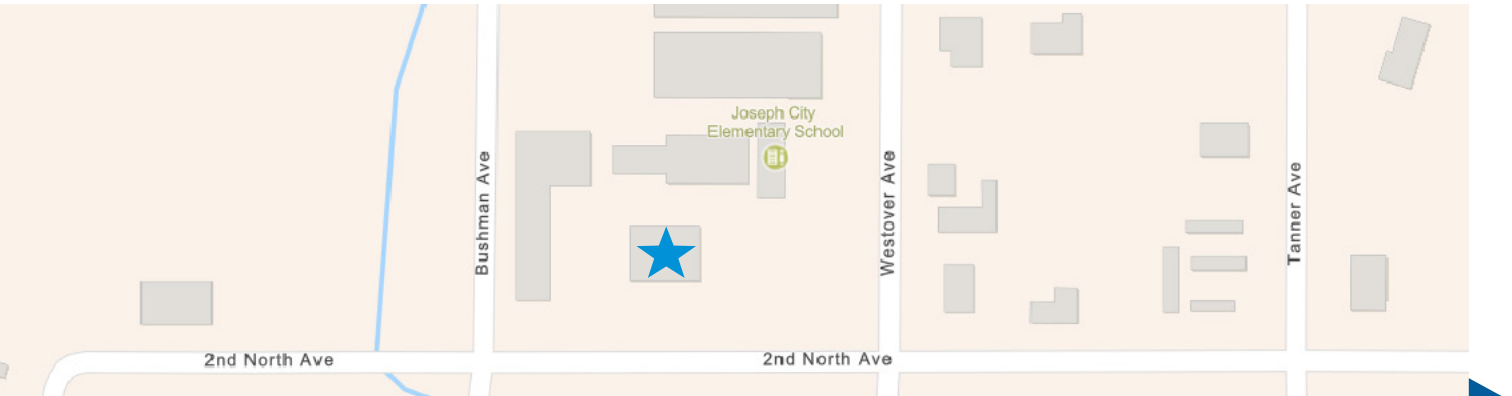
Environmental impact studies for the Cholla Conversion Project are underway. The results of these studies will be shared with the community during the in-person open house on July 28, 2026, and online at the virtual open house: www.aps.com/chollaconversion. The open house will provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the conversion project, ask questions and share their comments and feedback about the project.

In September of 2026, APS anticipates filing a request to amend an existing Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC), originally issued by the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) in 1973. The CEC amendment application will include information about the Cholla Conversion Project's environmental characteristics, public involvement, and public comments we receive. APS anticipates that the ACC will consider the CEC amendment application at an open meeting in the fall of 2026, and APS will provide specific information for the meeting once it is available. The ACC open meeting will include an opportunity for public comment.

APS will file an air permit application with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) in July 2026. The ADEQ and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will review the application and air quality analysis to ensure air quality in the area remains within established guidelines. The air permit process also will include an opportunity for public comment.

Where can I learn more?

We will be in your area to share project information, answer questions and gather your input at our upcoming open house. At this event, there will be no formal presentation.
