

BIANCO 230KV TRANSMISSION LINE SITING PROJECT

Arizona Public Service (APS) has started studies to determine appropriate routes for new power lines in Casa Grande and unincorporated Pinal County. These facilities will connect the new Bianco Substation with existing transmission infrastructure and will include 69kV, 230kV and 500kV facilities, as illustrated in the map included

Various environmental and engineering factors will be studied, and we will be reaching out to the affected communities to gather input

locations for the new power lines to best meet

the needs of our customers and the community.

that will help us identify preferred routes and locations for the new power lines.

From there, we will apply for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC) to build Components 1 and 2 of the project (see map).

This will require us to appear at a hearing before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (Committee) to present the project. If approved by the Committee, the CEC will be presented to the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) for review and final approval.



We started studies to determine appropriate locations for 69kV, 230kV and 500KV transmission lines, including structures and poles approximately 65 to 195 feet tall. They will be placed in new or existing rights-of-way or easements ranging from 60 to 200 feet wide.



This project provides improved infrastructure to support the current and future needs of APS customers. These facilities will provide additional reliability and redundancy for the APS transmission system in Pinal County.

Your input will help us determine routes for five new transmission lines in the Pinal County area. These routes will connect the new Bianco Substation near North Bianco Road, north to the existing Santa Rosa Substation, east to the existing Casa Grande Substation and southeast to the existing Weaver substation (see conceptual map).

PROJECT FEATURES

Monopole (single-pole) structures are typically used for new 230kV and 500kV transmission lines, but a variety of steel structure types may be used. Structure heights would be approximately 65 feet tall for 69kV monopoles, 115 feet for 230kV monopoles, and range between approximately 150 and 195 feet for 500kV monopoles depending on routing, terrain, and crossing of existing structures, including elevated roads and other power lines.

Any opportunity to use existing power line routes for the new structures will be considered. However, new rights-of-way and/or easements, approximately 60 to 200 feet wide, will be needed.
