### **2024 ASRFP Update**


- 2024 ASRFP was issued on Nov 20
- Seeking at least 2 GW of resources
- Unique opportunities (Agave Phase II, Ironwood, renewable generation on tribal land)
- Resource years targeted
  - Near term (2028 2030)
  - Mid to long-term (2031+)






### Record Demand in 2024; Forecast Increasing in 2025

Customer growth


Extra High Load Factor (XHLF) Customers

A balanced portfolio is essential to support reliable integration of intermittent resources




APS remains committed to collaborating with stakeholders and other utilities as efforts evolve






