- An APS team member will review participant's application for completeness and eligibility and status of available funding.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- An APS MEEP team member will visit your facility and take an inventory account of the available products to be installed in all units.
- MEEP participants are required to fill out and sign this application agreement to get the inventory ordered and delivered to the facility.
- Please provide a copy of one month's utility bill showing your property is served electricity by APS.
- Participants will have 30 days to install the products after delivery to the facility.
- An APS MEEP team member will then perform a post inspection to ensure all products have been installed.
- Any products left over after installation will be collected by an APS representative during the post-inspection process.
