Summary

On October 1, 2019, APS filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Notice of Intent to File a Rate Case Application and Request to Open Docket. As a result, this docket was opened. On October 31, 2019, APS Filed its Rate Application.

The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by APS, Staff, or any Intervenors. The Commission will determine the appropriate relief to be granted in response to APS's application based on the evidence presented in this matter. The final rates approved by the Commission may be higher, lower, or different than the rates proposed by APS or by other parties.
