

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF CHANGES TO THE PUBLIC COMMENT MEETINGS TO BE HELD
ON ARIZONA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY'S ("APS's") RATE APPLICATION DOCKET
NO. E-01345A-19-0236**

Summary

On October 31, 2019, APS filed a Rate Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission"). The Rate Application was found to be sufficient by the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") on November 29, 2019, and an evidentiary hearing for the Rate Application is currently scheduled to commence on September 30, 2020.

On February 25, 2020, the Commission scheduled four evening public comment meetings to be held in June 2020 in various locations within APS's service territory, to receive public comment on the Rate Application.

The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by APS, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will determine the appropriate relief to be granted in response to APS's application based on the evidence presented in this matter. The final rates approved by the Commission may be higher, lower, or different than the rates proposed by APS or by other parties.
