We've stopped disconnections through Oct. 15 and are offering bill assistance.



We will not disconnect service due to past-due bills, and are waiving late fees, through October 15, 2022.

If you're struggling to pay your energy bill, let's work together to find a solution that helps prevent your balance from building. Options include flexible payment arrangements, assistance programs, and resources that may help reduce your monthly payment or pay down your bill.

Energy Support program offers 25% off monthly energy bills.

Crisis Bill Assistance can provide up to \$800 a year to cover APS bills.

Project SHARE provides up to \$300 in temporary bill assistance through The Salvation Army.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is government assistance for heating and cooling bills.
