September is National Preparedness Month. We prepare year-round to reduce wildfire risk and be ready should one occur. Here's how you can, too:

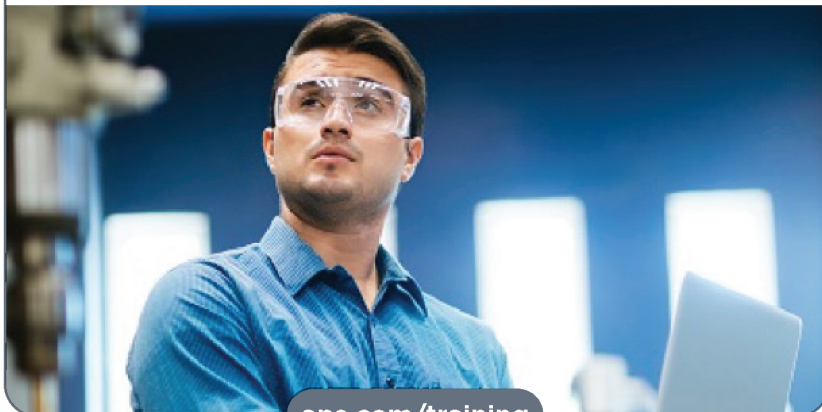
- Remove vegetation and ensure electrical equipment is clear of debris.
