



**RATE RIDER E-36 M
CLASSIFIED SERVICE
STATION USE SERVICE MEDIUM**

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available to generating plants with a power supply capacity requirement of less than 3 MW.

DESCRIPTION

This rate rider serves start-up and auxiliary load requirements for generating plants. Two pricing tiers are available based on the Customer's annual average monthly demand during the summer billing cycles of May through October.

CHARGES

The monthly bill will consist of the following:

Bundled Charges

This schedule has two billing options: E-32 XS for customers with average monthly demands less than or equal to 20 kW, and E-32 L for customers with average monthly demands greater than 20 kW. The charges are as follows:

E-32 XS Option Customer will be billed according to the provisions in Rate E-32 XS except that the basic service charges will be replaced with the charges below and the other charges will be replaced with the following seasonal kWh charges.

Summer kWh	\$0.13514	per kWh
Winter kWh	\$0.11797	per kWh

E-32 L Option: Customer will be billed according to the provisions in Rate E-32 L except that the basic service charges will be replaced with the charges below.

SERVICE DETAILS

1. The Customer may net the kWh output of their generator provided to APS through a purchase power contract or other arrangement against the electricity provided by APS to the Customer for station use. Under this option, only the Customer Accounts Charge and the Revenue Cycle Service Charges in this schedule will apply.
2. The Customer must meet all interconnection requirements as determined by the Company. The Customer is responsible for all costs associated with interconnection of the Customer's generation facility to the Company's system.
3. All the terms and charges in the Customer's rate schedule, other than those specifically included here, continue to apply to electric service provided under this rider.
